Color	Antique rose, cherry.
Aroma	The aromas reveal a striking fruitiness featuring wild strawberries and candy.
Tasting profile	The fine effervescence and delicate palate are embraced by fruits of the forest nuances and a touch of freshness on the finish.
Full tasting Notes	A gentile rosé that is perfect for all social occasions.
Food pairings	Sublime with fried treats, fruit salads and gelato.
Winemaking notes	The grapes are fermented separately before being blended for the refermentation according to the Charmat method.
The story	Glera is a grape that's native to northeastern Italy, which has been known since Roman times. A white grape, it has hazelnut-hued vine shoots and produces large, long bunches with yellow-golden grapes.

DID YOU KNOW?

The style is extra dry, sweeter than the Brut version with residual sugar between 12 and 17 grams per liter, which makes this wine a joy to drink.
